OBJECTIVES AND OUTCOUME OF THE MEETING

THEME: Infection Prevention and Control beyond COVID-19: Embarking on New Horizons.

1. The purpose of the Pacific Infection Prevention and Control Network (PICNet) meeting is to provide a platform to strengthen Infection Prevention Control (IPC) capacity in the Pacific Islands and Territories (PICTs)through dialogue on the implementation of the core components of IPC, in-country technical support and training in IPC.

Meeting Objectives
