CHALLENGES

Communication & reliable internet services

Geography, diversity and remoteness



- 1. Remote and geographic dispersed Islands
- 2. Smaller hospital provide basic operating services and some have scarce resources, thus differs in levels of practices
- 3. Difficult to maintain skill sets as some island hospitals reshuffle nurses from time to time





Recommendations for governments:

- Promote implementation of Pacific Islands Operating Room Nurses Association (PIORNA) standards and analyze compliance through collation of audit results.
- 2. To support exchange programs (mentorship) of perioperative nurses to help maintain and upgrade nursing skills set in operating theatres.
- 3. To include education in post graduate studies in perioperative nursing with financial support for scholarships.
- 4. To support the development for hospital-based learning centres with reliable internet services for online learning and access to continuing professional development.

Recommendations for development partners:

- 1 To support plan of creating new PIORNA standards and audit tools and review standards.
- 2 To support PIORNA in developing relationships with appropriate education institutions.
- 3 To support the development of PIORNA to grow under the guidance of a well-established organisation (for example Australian College of Operating Room Nurses (ACORN) / IFPN).
- 4 To support PIORNA in conducting and publishing perioperative nursing research
